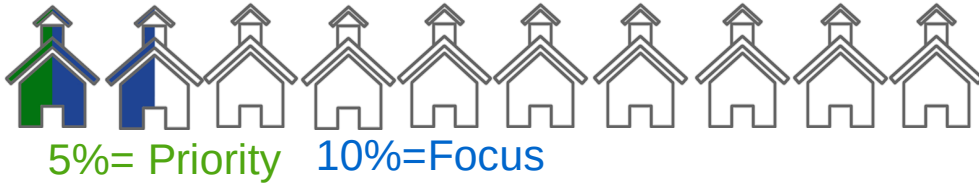

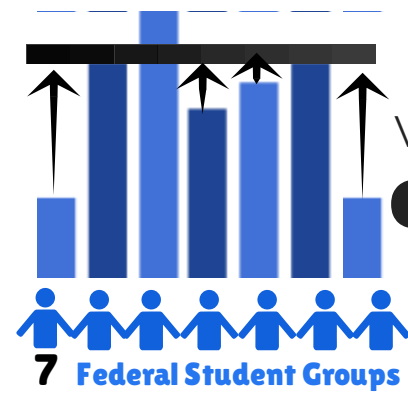

IMPROVEMENT REQUIRED

- 90 Day Strategy (DS)
- End of Year Report
- Quarterly Implementation Report (QIR)

- Do not submit 90 DS
- Targeted Improvement Plan
- End of Year Report
- QIR

- Continue with current Texas Education Code, Ch. 39 required interventions and reporting

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
